Bali, Indonesia, 22 – 23 March 2016**

The Sixth Ministerial Conference of the Bali Process on People Smuggling, Trafficking in Persons and Related Transnational Crime (BRMC) will be held on 23 March 2016 in Bali, Indonesia. The Conference will be co-chaired by the Ministers of Foreign Affairs from Indonesia and Australia. It will be preceded by a Senior Officials' Meeting on 22 March 2016. Forty eight members of the Bali Process are invited, along with 18 other participating countries, and 10 participating agencies.

The Sixth Ministerial Conference of the Bali Process will discuss the trends of irregular migration in region and the related transnational crimes. Established in 2002, the Bali Process is a regional forum to strengthen cooperation, facilitate discussion and information sharing on issues relating to human trafficking, people smuggling and related transnational crimes.

I. Introduction

Established in 2002, the Bali Process is a regional forum to strengthen cooperation, facilitate discussion and information sharing on issues relating to human trafficking, people smuggling and related transnational crimes. It is one of the biggest and oldest regional consultative processes on irregular migration that brings together countries of origin, transit and destination. The Bali Process is inclusive, voluntary and non-binding in nature and based on the principles of burden sharing and shared responsibility.

Since its establishment, Minister of Foreign Affairs of Indonesia and Minister of Foreign Affairs and Trade of Australia serve as the co-chairs.

Bali Process Ministerial Conference is the highest decision making mechanism of the Bali Process. The Sixth Ministerial Conference of the Bali Process on People Smuggling, Trafficking in Persons and Related Transnational Crime will be convened in Bali, Indonesia on 23 March 2016. In accordance with the common practice, the Conference will be co-chaired by the Ministers of Foreign Affairs from Indonesia and Australia. It will be preceded by a senior officials' meeting on 22 March 2016. Forty eight members of the Bali Process are invited, along with 18 other participating countries, and 10 participating agencies. The Head of Delegation for member countries is expected to be minister level.

The Sixth Ministerial Bali Process Ministerial Conference will discuss about the trends of irregular migration in the region and the related transnational crimes. The ministers are also expected to deliberate on ways to enhance the Bali Process cooperation, including by strengthening the Bali Process consultation mechanisms to address effectively any emerging and evolving regional issue of irregular migration.

II. Accreditation/Registration

A. Key dates for media accreditation

20 - 21 March 2016	: Issuance of media ID card

1. All media representative covering the Meetings must register online. On-site registration will not be available. Registration form and information about other requirements needed will be available at www.kemlu.go.id. Media registration will be opened from 22 February 2016 to 14 March 2016.

2. Fill-in the Media Registration Form and attach soft copies of the following documents:
 - a. Letter of assignment from the editor/executive of the media (file type: PDF).
 - b. A form of identification – KTP for locals or passport for non-Indonesian citizens – that is valid for at least six months (file type: PDF).
 - c. A recent digital passport-sized photograph (file type: jpg/png/bmp, with maximum size of 200 kb).

3. For successful media accreditation, an e-mail notification will be sent to confirm your accreditation together with a unique ID number.

PLEASE NOTE THAT INCOMPLETE AND LATE REGISTRATIONS WILL NOT BE PROCESSED.

III. Visa requirement (foreign journalists)

Registered foreign journalists (who are not based in Indonesia) are required to have a valid visa. Print and bring along the copy of the confirmation letter, passport and recent photograph to the nearest Indonesian Embassy/missions to apply for a journalist visa. List of Indonesian Embassies/Missions is available at <http://www.kemlu.go.id/en/kedutaan/default.aspx>

The application will be processed in accordance with applicable regulations, please note that confirmation letter does not guarantee issuance of visa.

IV. Customs clearance requirement

List of equipments that will be brought by applicants must be legalized by the nearest Indonesian Embassy/Representative office for importation and exportation purposes. It is advisable to obtain *CPD* and *ATA Carnet* to expedite custom clearance.

V. Issuance of accreditation pass (ID)

Registered foreign journalists will be issued accreditation to access the media center and press events during the meetings. Members of the press must personally obtain their badges by showing their media ID, valid international passport and official statement from their chief editors. The Media Secretariat at the Media Center will arrange Press Conference and Press Interviews on a case-by-case basis.

The Media Center will provide working table with internet access. Please bring along your personal laptop and other office equipment you may need.

IX. Accommodation and travel arrangements

Media representatives will be responsible for their own travel arrangements, reservation and payments of hotel/accommodation. The media are strongly urged to make reservation as early as possible.
